Directions to Manchester

From Trafford go down the M34 which turns into Deansgate:

- Pass Beetham Tower (Hilton) on the right carry on down Deansgate straight through the lights
- Straight through the next set of lights and finally left onto bridge street at the next set of lights
- We are 50m on the right hand side of the road. Carry on past the shop for parking at Short Stay car park or further down the road there are parking meters or a long stay car park at the bottom of road.

From the West you want the East Lancs road A580:

- Carry on past Salford University. At the third set of lights turn left
- onto New Bailey Street (This turns into Bridge Street over the river bridge).
- Just under the railway bridge on the right there is a long stay car park There are parking meters
- All around this area. Further up the road 50m on the left there is a short stay car park.
- The shop is past the lights on the left just after Starbucks.

From North Manchester

- M60 J17 onto the A34 towards Manchester approx 5 miles into city centre
- Past the Cathedral on the right. Go through the next set of lights and turn right at the next set of lights.
- Take the first left on to Parsonage gardens. This leads to Bridge Street. The shop is left onto Bridge street but you cannot turn left at the lights. However all the parking is to the right. There is a short stay as you turn right and further down there are ample meters and a long stay car park at the bottom.

From East Manchester.

- Join the A6 at the Apollo Theatre carry on towards the city centre and turn left onto
- The Mancunian Way (A57) follow signposts to Deansgate. At roundabout go right towards city centre.
- Pass Beetham Tower (Hilton) on the right carry on along Deansgate straight through the lights.
- Straight through the next set of lights and finally left onto Bridge Street at the next set of lights.
- We are 50m on the right hand side of the road. Carry on past the shop for parking at Short Stay car park or further down the road parking meters or an long stay at the bottom of road just over the bridge.
